



RECOMMENDED BIOSECURITY PRECAUTIONS

With the recent disease outbreaks, here are actions you can take to help minimize the chances of similar outbreaks in the future. We urge you to follow these safety measures to the maximum extent possible:

- ❖ When possible, use your own trailer and avoid shipping with horses from other farms.
- ❖ You may want to disinfect day & overnight stalls before putting your horses in them - use Lysol spray or a 10 bleach solution (1 part bleach to 10 parts water) sprayed on all surfaces, including the floor before adding bedding.
- ❖ Do not allow your horse to touch other horses, especially nose to nose.
- ❖ Bring and use your own equipment, feed and water buckets.
- ❖ If possible, avoid hand grazing, or at least seek out secluded areas.
- ❖ Wash your hands often, especially after handling other peoples' horses.
- ❖ Don't let members of the public or people from other stabling groups handle your horse or your equipment.
- ❖ When you return home, wash hands and change clothes and shoes before going around other horses.
