The minimum score requirement to enter Part 2 are three scores from three USEF-licensed dressage judges, two scores of 65% or higher at the highest test of Second Level and one score of 62% or higher at Third Level or above. Three scores of 62% or higher at Third Level or above from three different, or any combination of these requirements would also meet the requirements to enter Part 2. Only scores from USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competition(s) will count.

Anyone wishing to complete the L Education Program or retest that has exceeded five years from their last session will be required to participate in or audit all Part 1sessions and purchase access to the current L Education Program material.

Participants will be registered following the guidelines below:

- 1. On a first-come, first-served basis according to the date each application is received by the organizer. Any USDF member may attend Part 1 sessions as a Participant.
- 2. Only 30 Participants can be accepted into Part 1 per USDF Program Guidelines. A "wait list" will be created once 30 Participants have been approved.
- 3. Applications may continue to be accepted after the October 12, 2024 closing date if space is available.

If accepted into the VADA "L" Education Program as a Participant, I understand:

- 1. I am committed to attending all sessions. I commit to paying for all three sessions even if I cannot attend all three.
 - a. Session A: December 14-15, 2024
 - b. Session B: February 8-9, 2025
 - c. Session C: March 22-23, 2025
- 2. The total fee for all three sessions is \$1000 for VADA members; \$1050 for non-VADA members.
 - a. Checks will be made payable to VADA and sent to the address below.
 - b. Lunch is included both days.
 - c. Scholarships may be available by direct application to: The Dressage Foundation, your USDF Dressage Region, or your USDF Group Member Organization.
- 3. If cancelling participation PRIOR to October 12, 2024, VADA will refund the Participant's payment in full. After October 12, 2024, Participant must notify the organizer ASAP if unable to attend one or more sessions. The Participant, assisted by the program organizer and USDF staff, can try to locate a replacement candidate for one or more of the missed sessions. If a replacement is identified and attends, the original Participant will be reimbursed for each session minus a \$50 cancellation fee. No refunds will be issued for sessions not attended by a replacement Participant.
